

TRANSPORT

<u>Travel by road:</u> leave M6 J36 - A590, follow the signs for Barrow. Then A595 signs for Workington and Askam. In Askam cross the level crossing into Duddon Rd to the venue 100yds on right.


Travel by rail: Askam railway station

(Cumbria coast rail line)

Alternatively: train to Barrow-in-Furness and alight at Ulverston/Dalton or Barrow.
